Applications for the State Schools' Relief Prep Uniform Subsidy begin Monday 16th April 2018

What you need to know

Pack eligibility and CSEF	To be eligible to receive the package the student must be a Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) recipient. If the student does not have CSEF, they can register in 2018 when applications open, and your school will need to place an application for the CSEF Prep Uniform Package. To find out more about CSEF or to apply for assistance go to www.education.vic.gov.au/csef .
When	Applications can be submitted from Monday 16 th April 2018. This information can be found on our website www.ssr.net.au/schools . Applications close end of term 2 2018.
What's in the package	<i>To be advised and will be updated at the beginning of Term 1 2018.</i>
How do schools make an application?	Primary schools are required to make an application to SSR on behalf of the eligible parents at www.ssr.net.au/schools .
Cost to parents, vouchers and physical items	Where State Schools' Relief cannot supply uniform items directly to parents you will receive a voucher that subsidises the cost of uniform items. The voucher(s) can be redeemed at the schools uniform shop or an independent uniform retailer which will be listed on the voucher. Parents receiving vouchers may need to make a contribution towards the cost of individual uniform items. The amount a parent has to pay will depend on the retail purchase price and the State Schools' Relief subsidy.
