Earn points and certificates 😊</p> <p>Look for and identify numbers in the environment e.g. supermarket, letter boxes, magazines and number plates.</p> <p>Practise writing numbers, concentrating on correcting number reversal. Practise counting to and from 100 from any starting point.</p>	<p>Find a job at home you can help with, such as: Help set the dinner table, put your shoes away, make your bed, help make your lunch for school, make sure your reader is in your school bag each morning. Hang up your own bag at school and put your reader bag on your table.</p>
