Reading	Maths
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make reading part of your daily routine. It is important to continue to read to an adult. Talk about what you read to make sure you understand it.</li> <li>• While reading think about what you already know and think about your background knowledge to help your understanding e.g. ask yourself what does the book remind you of? Can I understand how the character is feeling? What have you noticed about the setting or characters?</li> <li>• Change the location of where you read, e.g. under a tree, in a bean bag, lying on the couch... make it fun!</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Log onto Mathletics every week. Your aim is to achieve at least a Bronze Certificate which is 1000 points each week</li> <li>• Practise the times tables that your class is focusing on, and then extend yourself with a set of your choice or division facts.</li> </ul>
